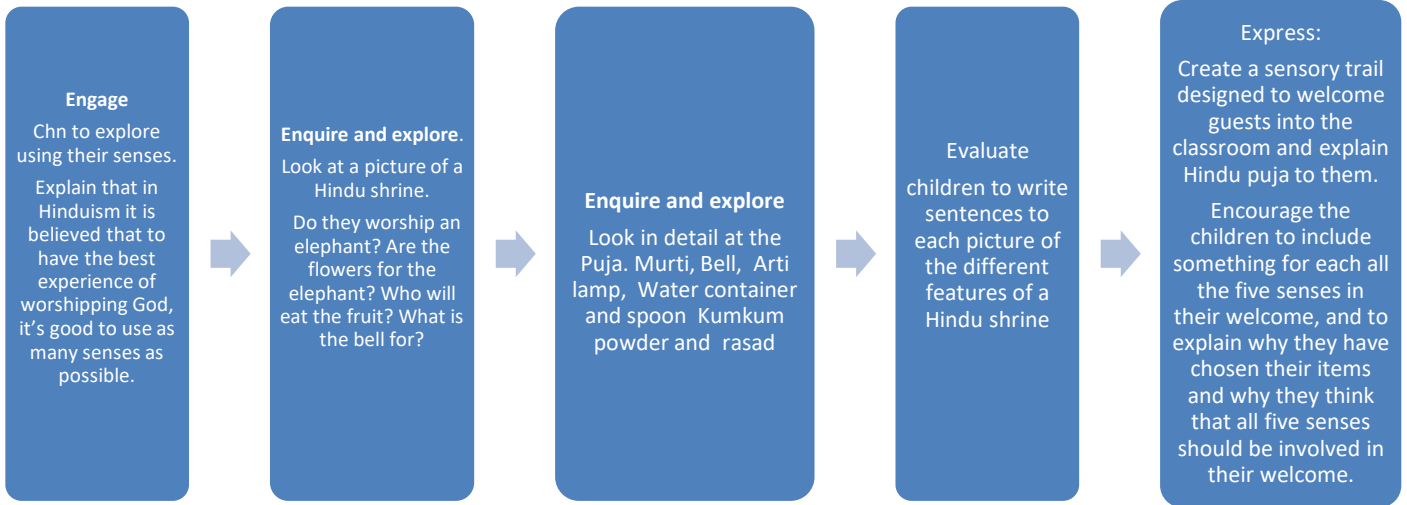


Year 1 RE – Enquiry 1 - Philosophy

What do my senses tell me about the world of religion and belief?

This unit focuses on using senses to explore the Hindu festival, Puja.



	Core learning – what we need to know
Knowledge – Children understand that....	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ The five senses (see, hear, smell, touch, taste) ✓ Worship practices, e.g. Hindu Puja ✓ Visual art, e.g. Murti / Image of Hindu God ✓ Artefacts, e.g. Art Lamp has five wicks one for each blessing ✓ Smell – incense is used as part of Hindu worship at a shrine ✓ Taste – food such as fruit is left at the shrine as an offering to the Gods
Outcomes – children will be able to ...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Ask “I wonder ...” questions about the world around us. ✓ Use our senses to investigate worship in different religious traditions. ✓ Use our senses to justify a belief that they hold.
