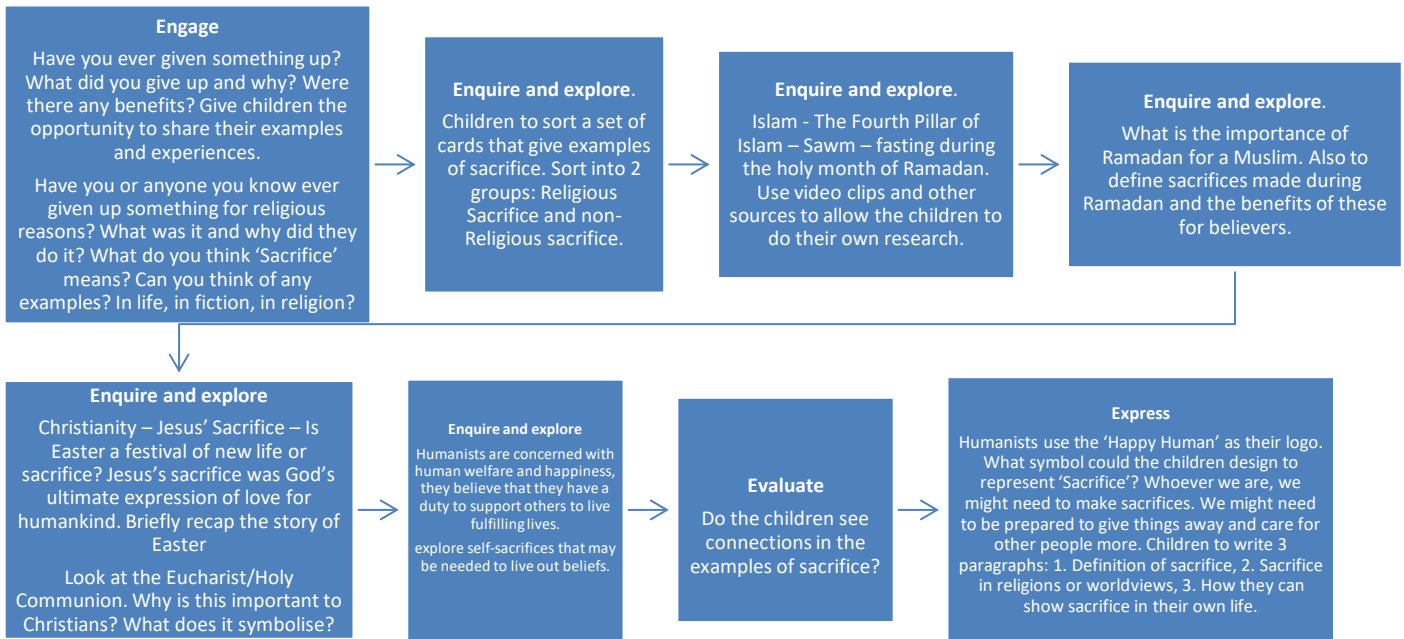


**Year 4 RE – Enquiry 5 – Philosophy**
