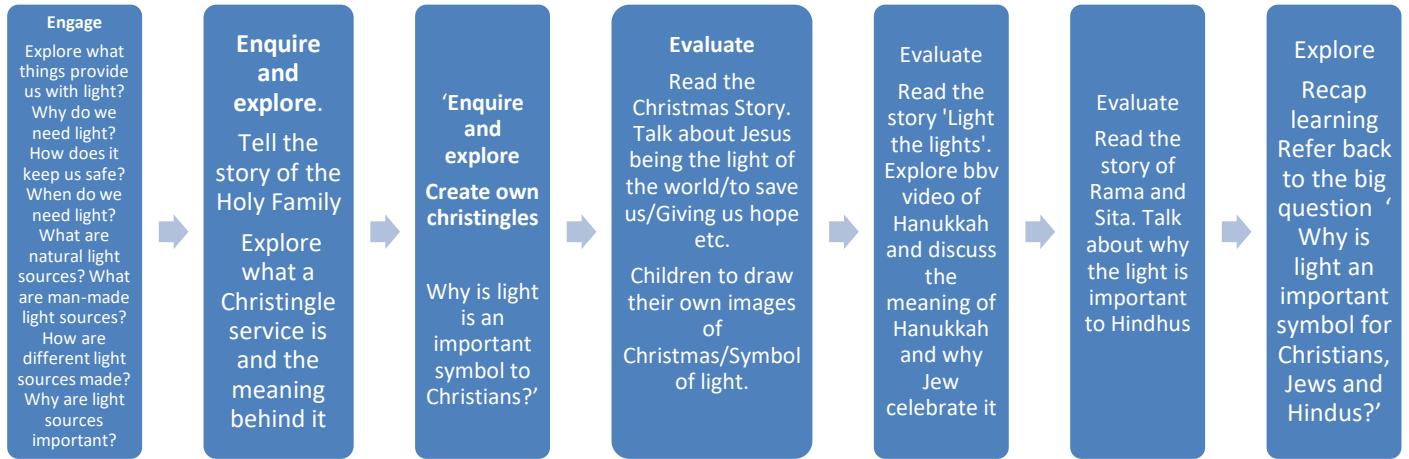


## Year 2 RE – Enquiry 2

This unit focuses on how light is used in festivals and other important religious events. Children will explore each religion and discover how light is used.



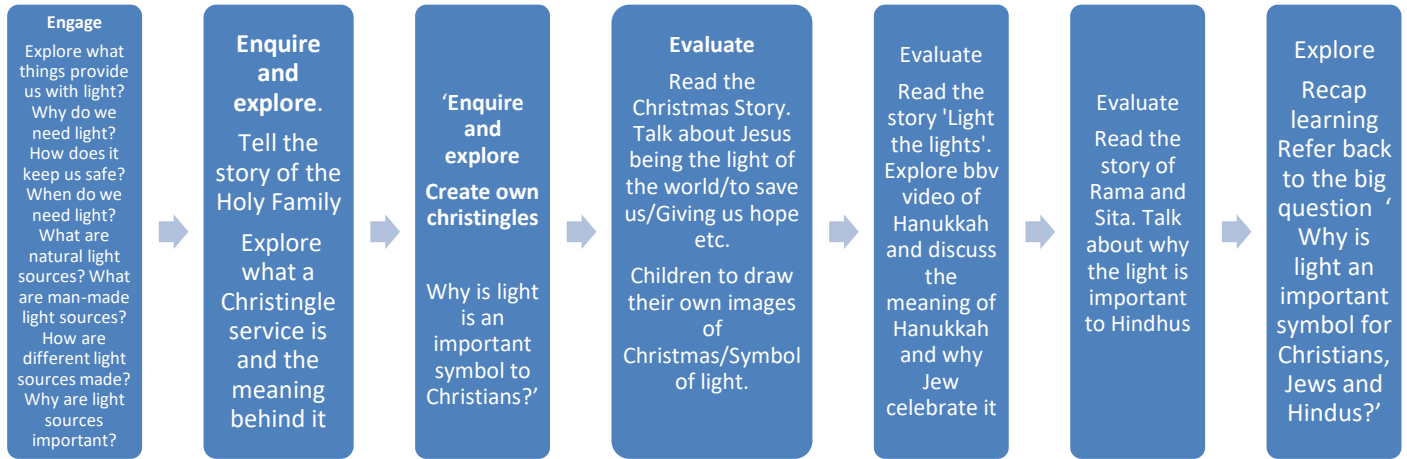
