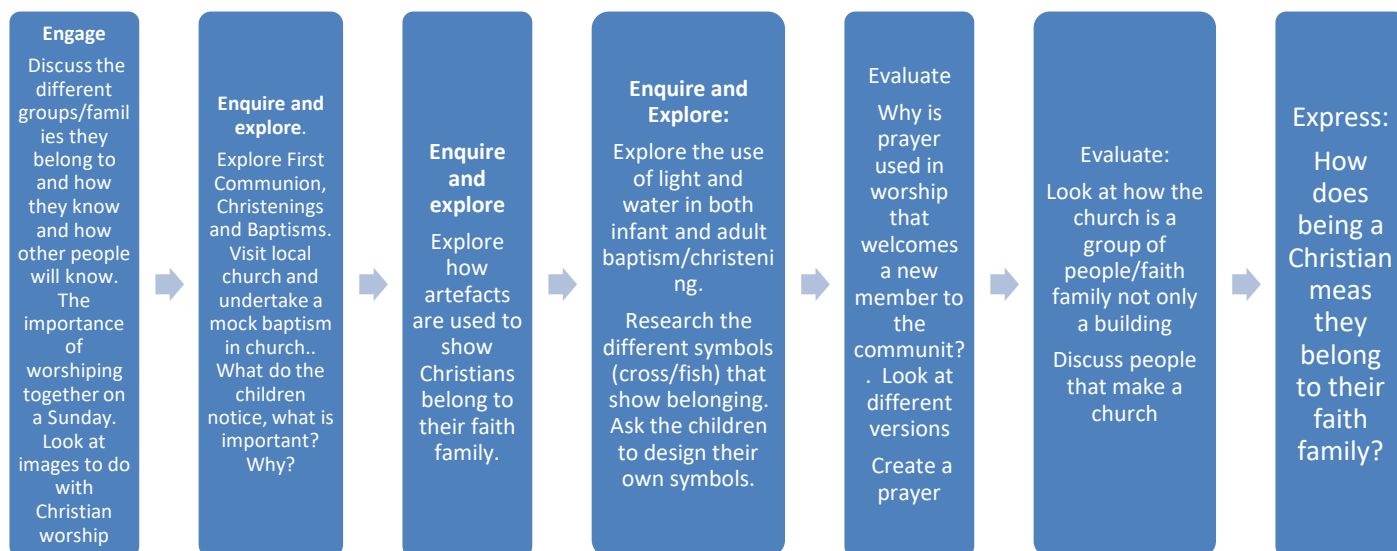


## How do Christians belong to their faith family?

This unit focuses on what it means to belong to the Christian faith family. Children will learn about key sacraments such as baptism, communion and confirmation. They will visit their local church and discuss the different symbols and people in the Christian family.



Core learning – what we need to know	
Knowledge – Children understand that....	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ The importance of worshipping together on a Sunday.</li> <li>✓ How First Communion, Christenings and Baptisms show Christians belong to their faith family.</li> <li>✓ How artefacts (font/christening candles/chalice and paten) are used to show Christians belong to their faith family.</li> <li>✓ How artefacts (prayer/hymn book) are used to show Christians belong to their faith family through worship.</li> <li>✓ The use of light and water in both infant and adult baptism/christening.</li> <li>✓ The different symbols (cross/fish) that show belonging.</li> <li>✓ The church as a group of people/faith family not only a building.</li> <li>✓ How using the name Christian means they belong to their faith family.</li> </ul>
